



Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our commitment to supporting student well-being and health education, your child will be included in a Breast Cancer Awareness lesson during the week commencing Monday 13th October 2025.

It will be delivered by their form tutor using resources provided by CoppaFeel! who are the UK's first breast cancer awareness charity.

Although breast cancer is a serious topic, CoppaFeel! approaches it in an age-appropriate way. They aim to encourage young people to check monthly, educate them to know the signs of breast cancer and empower them to contact their GP if they notice any unusual changes to their chest.

When breast cancer is diagnosed early, treatments are more effective and survival rates are higher.

The lesson will include the following (but has been adapted for KS3 and KS4 students to ensure it remains age appropriate):

- Breast Cancer facts and statistics
- Changed genes
- CoppaFeel!'s mission
- How to check your chest
- Signs of breast cancer
- CoppaFeel!'s reminders to check

We hope the lesson will encourage healthy chest-checking conversations and help to break down any stigma or fear surrounding the topic of breast cancer awareness.

While staff were available to answer student questions during the lesson, your child may wish to continue the conversation at home or may have further questions.

We've attached some free CoppaFeel! resources that may support you in continuing these discussions with your child. You don't need to be an expert, and we encourage you to explore CoppaFeel!'s website at **coppafeel.org** for further information and guidance.
