We can't wait to see our talented students bring this fabulous, fun-filled musical to life. Good luck to everyone auditioning!



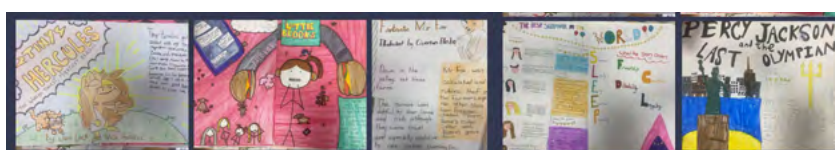
Summer Reading Project

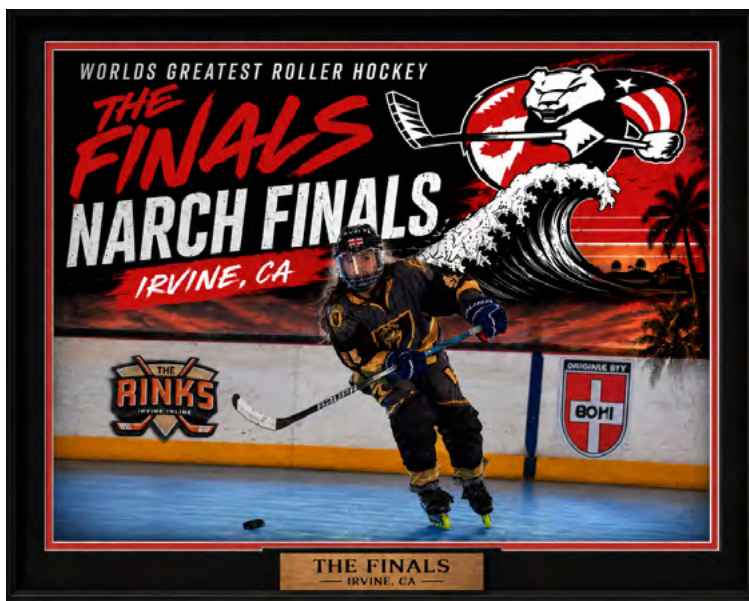
Avery's Sporting Summer
