As you will be aware, from August 2022, Hinckley Academy and John Cleveland Sixth Form Centre will be changing its name to become 'The Hinckley School' and I am writing to you today to share how our Sixth Form will align through this exciting rebranding process.

We are implementing a long list of significant positive changes and along with our transfer to The Futures Trust our investments in facilities and teaching and learning mean we now have a very exciting future ahead of us as a secondary and sixth form provider. With the launch of The Bridge, our specialist Year 7 provision, investment in teaching and learning, renovations across our site and plans for a brand-new STEM building currently being finalised, we are delighted to now be building a school which our community can be truly proud of. The combination of these developments means a fresh start and a brighter future for our community; therefore, it is important that we have an identity which is reflective of our new direction and vision for the future.
