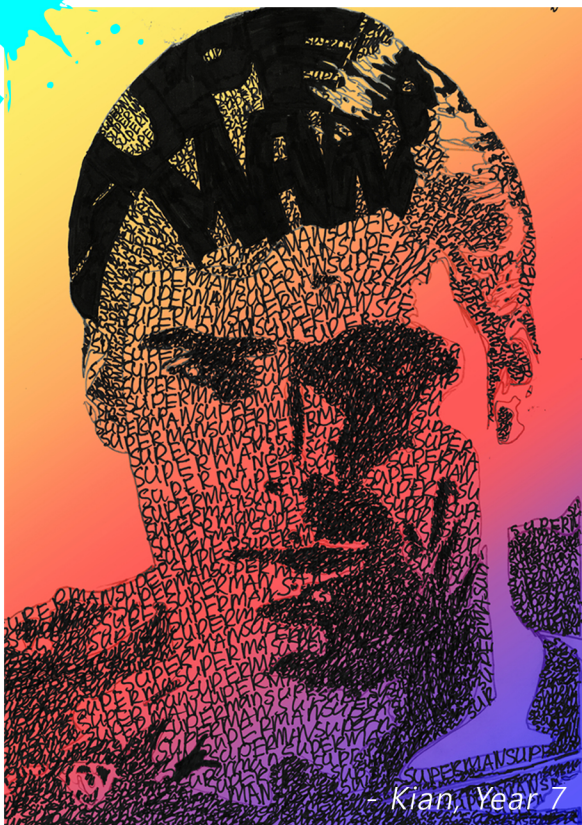


# Art in The Spotlight
