

Using the SIMS Parent Service

The SIMS Parent service will allow you to view your child's school reports, as well as their attendance, achievement awards and timetable.

You should have received an invitation email inviting you to "SIMS Parent". You might need to check your junk email folder if you don't see it.

Open the email and **Accept Invitation**:





To Sign in with an Apple, Facebook, Google, Microsoft or Twitter Account


Click **Register with External Account** and then choose one of:


You are required to provide a second piece of information to confirm your identity.

What is the date of birth of one of your children at the school? (dd/mm/yyyy)


The website will open and you will see the tile for your child shown in in the bottom right-hand corner. (Your screen layout might be slightly different depending on the device you are using to access it)

The reports are available on the Reports button:




When you select a report to open it, it may be displayed at the bottom of the screen, depending on which web browser you are using:
