For all other dietary requirements, please contact your Year Team directly.

All free school meal students will automatically be allocated a Christmas dinner. Please note that during each year groups dinner slot, no other hot food options will be available for students in that year group to purchase. Students may bring in their own packed lunch should they wish to. Water will be available to students during the meal, however, please be aware that no other drinks will be available to purchase during lunchtime.

Students across the three year groups, including those who bring in a packed lunch, will all sit together to enjoy the festivities, so that everyone can enjoy the event entertainment and atmosphere as a community.
