**KS4 Options Evening & Parents' Evening – Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2024**

As part of the KS4 option process we would like to warmly invite all Year 9 students and their families to our '**KS4 Options Evening**' held in our **Sixth Form Centre** on **Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2024, 5pm-6:30pm**. This event is an invaluable opportunity to gather information to support informed decision making and I encourage everyone to attend. During the evening there will also be an opportunity for families to discuss progress in core subjects by attending a pre-booked appointment with individual teachers for English and Maths.

The evening is broken down into three components, with families able to drop in to the event at the most convenient time for them:

- **Option Subject Fair – Cafe6 (Downstairs in the Sixth Form)**
  - Between 5pm-6:30pm our option subject specialists will be in Cafe6 to answer your questions. Each subject stall will feature examples of GCSE work and share further information about the course structure and assessments to help with the decision-making process. Upon arrival families will be given a map to help them to navigate around the option subject fair and a 'KS4 Options Guide' to continue conversations at home.
- **'Options Talk' - A9 (Downstairs in the Sixth Form) at 5:15pm, 5:45pm and 6:15pm**
  - During our '**Options Talk**', Mr Wood, Deputy Headteacher and Mr Fawkner, Assistant Headteacher, will share important information about the option process and key deadline dates. The talk is repeated three times during the evening and we encourage all families to attend one talk.
- **Parents' Evening: English & Maths Subject Appointments – Library, 4:30pm -6:30pm**
  - Families can discuss student progress in core subjects by attending a pre-booked appointment with individual teachers for English and Maths. To allow for the maximum possible appointment slots, these will begin slightly earlier than the options event, taking place between 4:30pm and 6:30pm in the Library. Please note that these appointments must be booked in advance and are on a first come first served basis. Instructions on how to book an appointment can be found below:
